### Driving Directions

**From the north:** Take I-5 South to Highway 512 East. Go East on 512 and take the Mt. Rainier/Highway 7 exit. Turn right on 7 heading toward Mt. Rainier to 304th St. E. turn left on 304th, go about 5 miles to 144th St. E. Turn right on 144th and follow the signs to Camp Lakeview and Camp Benbow.

**From the south:** Go North on I-5 to exit 111—Hwy 510 to Yelm. Turn right on 510, go through Yelm to 702 in McKenna. Turn right on 702 and go to Hwy 7. Turn left on 7 heading toward Tacoma to 304th St. E. Turn right on 304th, go about 5 miles to 144th St. E. Turn right on 144th and follow signs to Camp Lakeview and Camp Benbow.
